James J. Feeney, MD, Memorial Scholarship

Instructions and Policies

I. Eligibility for Scholarship

- A. Consideration is limited to applicants who
- Have been accepted in a college level pre-medical curriculum as full-time students
- Or
- Are currently enrolled as full-time students in an accredited medical school curriculum
- B. Applicants must be DeKalb County residents

II. Facts pertaining to JJF Memorial Scholarship:

- A. One scholarship will be awarded in the amount of \$1,000 for the academic year based on the availability of funds. Scholarship recipients may reapply annually for additional funds.
- B. Scholarships are awarded upon verification by the institution of student's enrollment. Recipient should request a verification letter be sent to Kishwaukee Health Foundation, P.O. Box 707, DeKalb, IL 60115.
- C. Check will be mailed to the recipient's school. If a recipient drops out of school, or switches from the pre-med/medical curriculum, funds must be returned commensurate with the remaining school year.
- D. Selection of recipient will be made in May for the following academic year.

IV. Applications:

- A. Transcripts from all academic institutions (high school and beyond) must accompany this application. High school transcripts are required if the applicant graduated from high school within the last 10 years. An application will not be considered without transcripts. *Prior recipients need submit only updated transcripts.*
- B. Official proof of acceptance to a school of higher education must accompany this application. Schools need not be Illinois institutions.

- C. Direct all documents to Kishwaukee Health Foundation, P.O. Box 707, DeKalb, IL 60115.

- E. Completed applications and supportive documentation must be postmarked by May 1 preceding the academic scholarship year.

V. Criteria:

Scholarships are awarded based on the following criteria:

- Acceptance in a pre-med or medical school curriculum at an accredited four-year college or university
- Financial need
- Scholastic record

VI. JJF Memorial Scholarship Committee

- A. Selection of each year's recipient will be based solely on the decision of the committee.
- B. The committee will be comprised of three members of the Feeney family (Mrs. James Feeney, Deirdre Feeney Mihm and Meegan Feeney Richards), a member of the Kish Hospital medical staff, and the Executive Director of Kishwaukee Health Foundation.
